To whom it may concern:

I have been using the Anti Bio system on my hydroponic farm for over a year now. At first I was skeptical about the effectiveness of the system, as I have used a similar product in the past, and found no benefit what so ever. Worse still, I paid over \$1000 for it, compared to the small monthly hire option that Anti Bio offer.

For the first week I noticed no difference at all in my hydroponics system, but then things started to change.

After 2-3 weeks, my systems started to block up really badly, and when flushing out my pipes, I noticed large amounts of brown scale when I flushed the lines. I flushed the lines daily for about 2-3 weeks, sometimes removing half a bucket of scale at a time. After this period, the amounts of loose scale dropped off dramatically. At the same time, the pressure and flow in the pipes improved noticeably. The overall effect is that my feeder pipes into my hydroponic channel block up far less often, resulting in lowered product losses.

As a result, I have installed the Anti Bio system on all 18 of my hydroponic systems, and they have been working successfully ever since.

A good indication for me that the Anti Bio system is working is that I don't notice it at all, compared previously to water pressure and flow slowly decreasing as the systems got older.

I would recommend the Anti Bio Product to anyone who has a NFT hydroponic farm.
