Dear Tim,

I would like to give you some feedback on the effects of installing a hydroponic Anti Bio unit on our hydroponic NFT system in which we grow herbs and salad greens.

Our hydroponic system is now 12 years old and we have quite a build up of bio film inside our pipes. We suspect that Pythium spores have been hiding there for years and they constantly rear their ugly heads and attack our plants when they are stressed – the roots would turn brown, the plants turn pink/purple and eventually they die.

We installed your unit 4 months ago. After 4 to 5 weeks we experienced a flare up of the pythium – but I was happy with that cause it could be an indication that the spores were loosening up and exiting through the system causing some damage in the mean time.

We now see a definite improvement in the health of our system: coriander roots are white instead of brown; dill keeps growing even under hot conditions; young rocket plants that stress out WILL turn a little purple but then turn GREEN again and keep growing – this has never happened before. Our production is up with between 15 % and 30 % compared with the same time last year when the pythium was quite rampant.

Our impression is that the anti bio unit is loosening up the spores from inside the pipes but the number of spores in the system is reducing and the plants are healthier and stronger for it.

We have adopted the following approach: once a week we flush out our pipes by dumping the tank. We then add sterilized water and Trichoderma. A few days later we add Bacillus Subtilus. We will keep repeating this cycle until the spores are all flushed out of the system.

Thanks for letting us try your product and I will certainly purchase it after the 6 months trial period.
